The 51<sup>st</sup> annual Scout, family and Parent Canoe Trip to the Manistee River will be held at Smithville Landing, located 16 miles north of Lake City, MI on M-66 north on the Manistee River. We will sleep in tents. NOTE: Many parents bring their own tents/trailer/campers and this is fine, as we often need the extra sleeping spaces. Also, some boys go on the trip without their parents and that is okay, too! We want parents along, but we don't want a boy to stay home if a parent can't make it. We also welcome siblings and friends! Some families/boys go up early on Friday to fish or play golf during the day, and that is also fine, but if you want a canoe or kayak on Friday, that will be up to you to arrange with the livery owner before you arrive. (231-839-4579) Scouts who come on the Canoe Trip are expected to canoe or kayak on Saturday. 2-3 people per canoe; 1 person per kayak - specify please! We will conduct a Troop Swim for scouts whose parents give their approval. The river is a safe one, and regular safety care will be discussed with all. Even non-swimmers make the trip each year, happily and often dry. Masks & social distancing will be mandatory!

## WHAT TO BRING/EQUIPMENT/CLOTHING:

## **NO SCOUT UNIFORM!!!**

Warm clothing (it often gets quite cold) (no electricity in the campground!)	Shoes (two pair, w/one sneakers or water shoes to wear in the canoe and maybe in the water)	Camp clothing (pj's, underwear)

Sweater/jacket/sweats	Raincoat/poncho	Sunglasses and string for glasses ~ sunscreen

THE TRIP WILL COST \$65.00 PER PERSON (\$38 CANOE; \$27 FOOD). Anyone who wants to kayak will pay an additional \$14. IF ANY ADULT IS NOT GOING TO CANOE, THERE IS A \$6 FEE FOR THE USE OF THE CAMPGROUND. THE COST FOR A NON-CANOEING ADULT IS \$35! Own canoes and kayaks are not permitted at Smithville.

We know it may be very cold at night. **BE PREPARED!** If the weather is not too wet, many boys/parents may wish to take in the local stock car races in Lake City on Sat. night, after dinner, or go into Traverse City for miniature golf or go-kart races. Estimated additional cost for these activities is about \$10 per person. Although many go each year, some also stay back for a campfire – it's up to you. Any questions? Give Mr. McCarley a call 734-634-0125. **Permission slips and money are due by Monday June 6th. If you're going, call McCarley by the end of May!** Whether you come up early Friday a.m., late Fri. night, or even early Sat. a.m. or leave Sat. night, the cost is the same. We leave the campsite to go to the river for 8:30 a.m. on Sat., so please plan accordingly.
